## *Chassagne-Montrachet*

### Chassagne-Montrachet Chardonnay 2013

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**Grape Variety :** Chardonnay

**Soil :** Clay and limestone

**Site :** Three plots of vineyards from selected "vignerons", ideally located in the heart of the village of Chassagne Montrachet - close to the Premiers Crus area. South, South-East orientation.

**The Vintage 2013 :** After a very cold winter and a demanding spring, the hot summer was regularly interrupted by rainy intervals which early September gave way to a bright and warm weather, that speeded up the maturation of the grapes. Harvest began in early October under a bright sunshine. Aging in oak during 12 months.

**Tasting :** Pale gold colour. Delicate floral fragrances mixed with yellow fruit and almond. Delicate vanilla note. Well-structured and complex. Tight and taut with a beautiful texture. Very pure fruit. Long with a hint of minerality.

**Food pairing :** To be enjoyed with foie gras, grilled fish, white meat and strong cheeses (Epoisses, Roquefort and Munster).
