Grape Variety : Pinot Noir

Soil : Mix of Clay and limestone

Site : Gevrey Chambertin is located in the "Côte de Nuits". The grapes stem from a selected plot in the northern part of Appellation "Gevrey Chambertin" located on a mid slope and bordering the Premiers Crus. The grapes are sourced from a partner winegrower. Picking of the grapes by our teams.

The Vintage 2015 : After a cold winter and a mild spring, the weather conditions in Summer were ideal with cold nights and warm days and enabled a perfect maturation of the grapes. The harvest started early September under a bright sunshine. The red wines develop beautiful aromas of ripe red and black berries with a fleshy texture. Aging in oak casks during 16 months.

Tasting : Dark ruby colour. Intense aromas of dark berries (blueberry) mixed with hints of cacao. Deep, complex. Very pure fruit. Tight and silky texture. Finely grained tannins. Persistent and intense finish. "COUP DE COEUR" Guide REVUE DU VIN DE FRANCE 2018 - Score 17/20
