## *Puligny-Montrachet*

### Puligny-Montrachet 2016

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**Grape Variety :** Chardonnay

**Soil :** Clay and limestone

**Site :** In the south of the Côte de Beaune, the terroirs of Puligny-Montrachet produce some of the greatest white Burgundies, including the famous Grand Cu Montrachet. The grapes vinified by Chanson are sourced from excellent plots of vineyards on mid-slope.

**The Vintage 2016 :** After a cool winter and a frost episode in April, the weather at the end of spring was warmer but rainy which engendered a late flowering and Millerandage (small size berries) . The summer was warm and dry. The harvest took place mid september under a bright sunshine. The white wines of the Mâconnais are precise and well-balanced with a well-shaped minerality.

**Vinification :** after a mild pressing, this wine was vinified and aged for 12 months in oak casks in our cellars of the XVth century. Moderate proportion of new oak.

**Tasting :** Pale gold colour. Delicate fragrances of lime blossom mixed with aromas of citrus fruit on a hint of minerality. Well structured and complex. Ample texture. Precise with a long and mineral finish.

**Food pairing :** Seafood, fish, mild cheeses as well as certain goat cheeses.
