Grape Variety : Aligoté

Soil : Mix of silt and chalk

Site : The area of production is located in the "departements" de Saône et Loire et de Côte d'Or.

The Vintage 2005 : Harvest took place in the early days of September after a dry and very hot summer after a superb growing season - long and cold winter followed by a rainy and humid spring. Exceptional weather conditions for an exceptional vintage. Full maturation of the grapes and good concentration.

Tasting : Pale gold colour. Floral fragrances enhanced by a light mineral note. Crisp, well-balanced and mineral. Very refreshing.

Food pairing : Aperitif, mixed salad, and cooked pork meat "charcuteries".
