“A broad-ranging nose displays ripe aromas of plum, cassis, earth, game, smoke and plenty of spice nuances, all of which is trimmed in just enough wood to notice. There is outstanding size, weight and mid- palate concentration to the powerful, velvety and stony big-bodied flavors that coat the palate with dry extract that also does a fine job of buffering the very firm but not really robust finale. This could be the best wine in the range in 2015 though the Clos des Fèves may well give it a run for its money in time. 2030+”

## 2014 VINTAGE

« Soft wood frames an overtly earthy, ripe and once again distinctly cool nose of both red and dark pinot fruit that is cut with plenty of earth and herbal characters. There is excellent complexity to the delicious middle weight plus flavors that possess both good volume and an almost pungent minerality, all wrapped in a beautifully long and only mildly austere finale that avoids overt rusticity. Note that moderate patience will be required here. 2024+ »

## 2011 VINTAGE

"This is a powerful wine with complex structure, dense fruits and a solid texture. It's dry, firm, dark and still very young. The core of the wine is still tannin, the black cherry fruit giving so much richness before the fresh acidity cuts in. Drink from 2018."

"Rather ripe, full and upfront. A big juicy wine with plenty of tannins. Broad and muscular structure. More power than elegance. A beefy wine with a long, assertive finish. Does it has the complexity for a grand cru ? From 2018."

"As one might reasonably expect this is markedly less expressive than the Beaune 1er with its restrained nose of both red and dark berry fruit, earth, humus, smoke and exotic tea scents. There is impressive volume to the well-muscled and broad-shouldered flavors that possess plenty of underlying tension, all wrapped in a complex, rustic and moderately austere finish. This will require at least a decade to be at its best. 2021+"

## 2010 VINTAGE

"Not an enormous, obvious step up from the premiers crus. Very juicy with some vibrant fruit underneath. Very dry finish. Good but not stunning."

"(from le Meix). A highly complex and pungently earthy nose of intense floral notes is accompanied by ripe cassis and dark berry fruit. The supple, round and delicious flavors are unusually accessible for a young Corton and this terminates with a slightly sweet if moderately long finish. An atypical if perfectly good example. 2020+"

"In the south part of the appellation with a southerly exposition under Le Charlemagne. This is new. Quite soft aroma. Subtle and easily accessible. It is fluid and pure and ripples gentle across the palate. There is some minerality threaded

with the fruit. Soft, fine grained tannins. It has charm, but lacks some substance for grand cru. From 2016"
