2011 VINTAGE

"Whole clusters vinification. Clusters are ripe with no harsh tannins. According to Jean Pierre Confuron, "when the stem is very ripe, it is like a fruit." On the palate, this wine is round and elegant. There is more structure than in the Côte de Beaune, and the pinot noir character is quite present."
