«Gilles de Courcel does not specify whether this is a domaine wine or not or if it has been harvested by hand. The House is implementing traditional methods of winemaking using full bunches of grapes during the fermentation process that is to say by macerating the grapes with the stems, giving firm wines with a good aging capacity. The nose on this Gevrey is quite restrained and needs some air to give off aromas of cherry, raspberry and blackberry. On the palate, it is crunchy and spicy slightly more austere on the finish.
