# **2012 VINTAGE**

"We awarded a score of 16.75+/20 this wine in 2012 vintage in May 2015 and afterwards we considered that this rate was certainly a bit harsh but it was poured after a magnificent Beaune Clos des Fèves 2012 which was rated with a 18.5/20. Shiny ruby color. Very open and accessible with delicate floral fragrances, a beautiful aromatic combination that makes you dizzy with notes of black berries, wood spices, dried flowers. Beautiful complexity. On the palate the wine is both taut and soft with notes of red fruit mixed with spices. The tannins are still quite present but the structure is still shaping up. A beautiful wine in a lesser known appellation. 2017-2030."

This 2009 vintage has a nice and bright ruby colour. Very fresh red berries aromas (cherry, raspberry) mixed with liquorice and spices. Complex and deep structure. Dense and delicate texture with tightly woven tannins. Well integrated oak note. Generous and vibrant finish supported by a generous fruit.
