

"There is a trace of exoticism to the spicy white fruit compote-like aromas that give way to silky, pure, detailed and seductively textured flavors that possess plenty of volume, indeed they are almost oily, on the expansive, highly complex and balanced finish. "There is a very mild trace of reduction to the otherwise cool and restrained floral and white orchard fruit aromas that display background nuances of wood and spice. There is impressive volume to the quite seductively textured medium-bodied flavors that possess plenty of mouth coating extract that buffers well the moderately firm acid spine on the mineral-driven, dry and balanced finish. This is not presently super complex but the underlying material is certainly present to allow it to develop and my score awards the benefit of the doubt in this regard. 2017+ "

«Here the nose is quite strongly reduced and I would advise decanting this if you're going to try one young. Otherwise, there is a mild toastiness to the very round, forward and subtly mineral-inflected medium-bodied flavors that offer good length. The nose confers a somewhat awkward aspect to the overall impression however and it's not clear how this will age. "

2008 VINTAGE

"The Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru Les Folatières stems from a parcel with a chalky soil with an important proportion of clay which gives to this wine a subtle minerality. The vines are oriented South-East. The grapes are pressed with a pneumatic press so that only the heart of juice is kept. Fermentation takes place in oak barrels at low temperature and then the wine matures for a period of 14 months with regular stirring to aquire more richness. Beautiful pale gold color. Aromas of white fruit mixed with notes of smoke, a nice minerality and vanilla notes from the maturation in oak barrels. The attack is powerful and well balanced. The finish is long, taut and mineral. This long-aging wine from Domaine Chanson Père et Fils must be stored for a few years. It will be a perfect match for foie gras, river fish, seafood and goat cheese."
