« One year old barrel yet it dominates. The wine underneath it is tight, mineral and focused. The energy is zesty and lively and the line is long. However the more overt character of the barrel from this cooper dominates at the moment, masking the purity, but the minerality of the wine comes through on the finish. It is fortunate that this is just one of five barrels and the others are not from this cooper.
